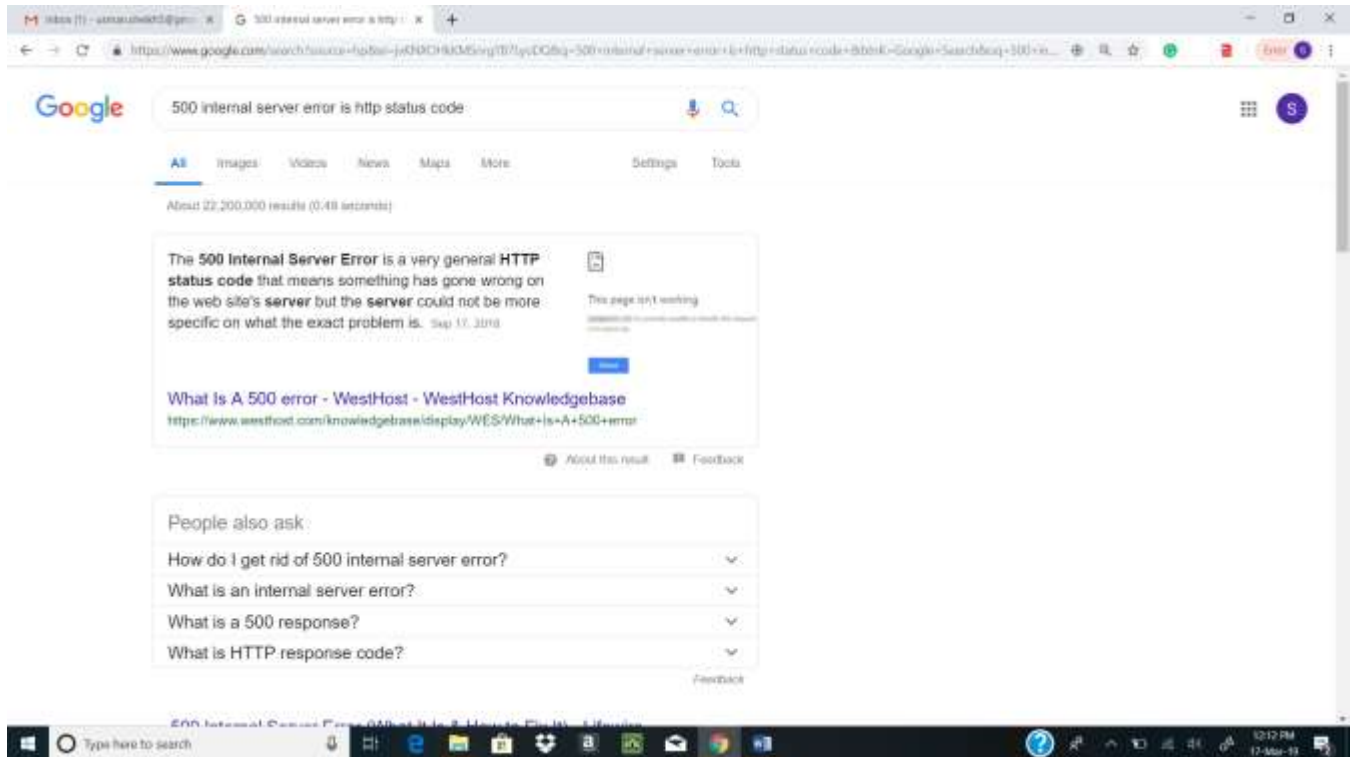
Parallel: the more universal/generalized can be used a strategy for problem solving, the better is this strategy.

The Middle Eastern country possesses 18 percent of the world's proven petroleum reserves and ranks as the largest exporter of petroleum. Its oil and gas sector accounts for about 50 percent of its GDP, and about 85 percent of its export earnings.

In 2016, Saudi Arabia played a key role in OPEC's decision to curb oil output, and as mentioned, prices have improved since then. However, in 2018 the country has increased its output by 1 million bpd, and prices have dipped. Saudi Arabia will be attending the next G20 meeting in Argentina, alongside the US and Russia, where members will negotiate on the next move for controlling oil prices.

## 3. Russia

Production: 11,210,000 bpd

Russia's oil output has been increasing steadily over the years, but sank a little from 11,240,000 bpd in 2016 to 11,210,000 bpd last year. Despite coming in as the third top 10 oil-producing country, Russia is the world's largest producer of crude oil and the second-largest producer of dry natural gas, according to the EIA. Most of Russia's reserves are located in West Siberia, between the Ural Mountains and the Central Siberian Plateau, and in the Arctic offshore region, extending into the Kara Sea.
